# "NATIONAL PITCHING RESEARCH COMPETITION"



#### **APPLICATIONS ARE NOW OPEN!**

National Pitching Research Competition (NPRC) is the Sri Lankan version of the InSPiR2eS Global Pitching Research Competition (IGPRC). The NPRC is conducted for the first-time in Sri Lanka by the Postgraduate Institute of Management (PIM), University of Sri Jayewardenepura with the collaboration of the InSPiR2eS international research network. The InSPiR2eS network is a globally-facing research network primarily aimed at research training and capacity building, resting on a foundation theme of responsible science. The NPRC is organized according to the global norms and standards developed by the InSPiR2eS and the overall winner is qualified to present his/her pitch at the semi-final stage of the global competition which will be held in Australia 2022. An international panel of judges will evaluate the winners at the Grand Finale of the NPRC.

Prof. Robert Faff, as the inventor of the pitching concept, will join the information session.

CORE TASK: You are required to complete the prescribed 2-page template, a template that provides a simple, methodical tool to confidently/succinctly "pitch" essential elements of a new research proposal to an academic expert i.e. to your PhD/DBA/MPhil supervisor.
