InSPiR2eS Global Pitching Research Competition 2025 (IGPRC2025) General Information & Timelines ... Strathmore University Chapter

Background

Following on from the great success of the first three editions of the InSPiR2eS Global Pitching Research Competition (IGPRC) ... <u>IGPRC2022</u>, <u>IGPRC2023</u>, <u>IGPRC2024</u> ... the fourth edition IGPRC2025 is now underway! In partnership with the Strathmore University (SU), and our **Platinum sponsors**: Corvinus University of Budapest, Elsevier and APAEA, we are very pleased to announce a SU competition that feeds into IGPRC2025. The information below is specifically directed to the Strathmore Chapter competition!

Core Task

The core task of this competition is to produce a written 1,000-word novel research pitch using the "pitching research" framework, PRF (see the skeleton PRF tool on the following page). For a detailed explanation of the PRF, see the latest version of the SSRN paper "Pitching Research" [Faff (2024)].

Eligibility

- open to research-enabled and research-focused students from any discipline: currently active Higher Degree Research (HDR) students e.g., PhD, DBA, Masters.
- participants must have a Strathmore University affiliation.
- participants must register as Inspires members (free membership).

Competition Prizes and Awards

The total prize pool for IGPRC2025 is approximately €10,000. For the Strathmore University Chapter competition, the overall SU winner receives €300; and subject to reaching a quality threshold, second receives €200, and third place receives €100. Additionally, the SU winner will automatically advance to an all-Africa competition, in which a small select set of Africa-based Chapter winners will vie to be crowned the Continental winner (with a €1,000 prize). AND then, the all-Africa winner automatically advances to the grand-final phase of the IGPRC2025 ... and maybe win the major IGPRC prize!

Important Dates & Timeline

- February 2025: web portal will open to receive "SU-Chapter IGPRC2025" entries (https://pitchmyresearch.com/main/competitions)
- 14 July 2025: final deadline for submission of SU Chapter entries.
- 4 August 2025: announcement of IGPRC2025 SU Chapter finalists.
- 8 September 2025: SU-Chapter IGPRC2025 Final in-person on campus (details to come).
- November 2025: determination and announcement of IGPRC2025 grand finalists.
- **January 2026:** "gala" online Grand Final comprising at least 6 IGPRC2025 finalists drawn from all around the globe (the IGPRC2025 winner will be determined by the combined quality of written and oral pitch).
