# InSPiR2eS Global Pitching Research Competition 2025 (IGPRC2025) General Information & Timelines ... Stellenbosch University Chapter

### Background

Following on from the great success of the first three editions of the InSPiR2eS Global Pitching Research Competition (IGPRC) ... <u>IGPRC2022</u>, <u>IGPRC2023</u>, <u>IGPRC2024</u> ... the fourth edition IGPRC2025 is now underway! In partnership with the Stellenbosch University (StellU), and our **Platinum sponsors**: Corvinus University of Budapest, Elsevier and APAEA, we are very pleased to announce a StellU competition that feeds into IGPRC2025. The information below is specifically directed to the Stellenbosch Chapter competition!

#### **Core Task**

The core task of this competition is to produce a written 1,000-word novel research pitch using the "pitching research" framework, PRF (see the skeleton PRF tool on the following page). For a detailed explanation of the PRF, see the latest version of the SSRN paper "<u>Pitching Research</u>" [Faff (2024)].

#### Eligibility

- open to research-enabled and research-focused students from any discipline: currently active Higher Degree Research (HDR) students e.g., PhD, DBA, Masters.
- participants must have a Stellenbosch University affiliation.
- participants must register as InSPiR2eS members (free membership).

## **Competition Prizes and Awards**

The total prize pool for IGPRC2025 is approximately  $\leq 10,000$ . For the Stellenbosch University Chapter competition, the overall StellU winner receives  $\leq 300$ ; and subject to reaching a quality threshold, second receives  $\leq 200$ , and third place receives  $\leq 100$ . Additionally, the StellU winner will automatically advance to an all-Africa competition, in which a small select set of Africa-based Chapter winners will vie to be crowned the Continental winner (with a  $\leq 1,000$  prize). **AND then**, the all-Africa winner automatically advances to the grand-final phase of the IGPRC2025 ... and maybe win the major IGPRC prize!

#### **Important Dates & Timeline**

- February 2025: web portal will open to receive "StellU-Chapter IGPRC2025" entries (<u>https://pitchmyresearch.com/main/competitions</u>)
- **28 July 2025:** final deadline for submission of StellU Chapter entries.
- 18 August 2025: announcement of IGPRC2025 StellU Chapter finalists.
- 16 September 2025: StellU-Chapter IGPRC2025 Final in-person on campus (details to come).
- November 2025: determination and announcement of IGPRC2025 grand finalists.
- January 2026: "gala" online Grand Final comprising at least 6 IGPRC2025 finalists drawn from all around the globe (the IGPRC2025 winner will be determined by the combined quality of written and oral pitch).
